- Music and The Spoken Word was a fantastic way to start the day! Yesterday, it was all about prayer (something you'll read a lot in the following paragraphs). I wrote down, "Our faith need not be perfect for us to ask for help... Have enough faith to ask for more faith."

- Elder Jeffrey R. Holland of the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles gave a talk about finding truth and answers. He talked about how sometimes the answers we may get from God are
